

At a special call meeting of the Fleming County Fiscal Court held Thursday, January 21, 2016 at the Fleming County Courthouse, 100 Court Square, Flemingsburg, Kentucky. Meeting was called to order at 7:30 AM by Fleming County Judge/Executive Larry H. Foxworthy. Magistrates present: David J. DeAtley, John Sims Jr., James Smoot, Rickey Lewis and Ray Money. Magistrate Chris Hickerson was absent. County Attorney John C. Price was present.

Public Hearing held regarding the adoption of 0.30 miles of Boardwalk Avenue located in Park Place Subdivision. Two viewers and county road supervisor made the recommendation in writing to accept the roadway. Public notice was published in accordance with Kentucky Revised Statute.

An agreement was signed between the County of Fleming, Robert Hatfield, Tina Hatfield and Meadowbrook Homes stating that additional ditch line sloping, seeding and straw applied will be completed on Boardwalk Avenue within 90 days.

It was decided that an easement for snow removal would not be needed.
